

HOW TO UPLOAD YOUR ARTWORK

The only way to submit your contest entry is to upload a photo of your artwork by 11:59 PM MDT on July 11. If you are ready to submit a digital photo of your final contest entry, we're ready for you!

1. Go to www.PaintTheStateIdaho.org and click on LOGIN.

2. Enter the email and password that you listed when you registered online. If you registered by hard copy form, enter the email that you listed on the form, and the password that was emailed to you by the Idaho Meth Project.



3. Click on BROWSE and locate the photo that you wish to upload.

4. Complete the fields provided and supply as much detail as possible about your project. This should include information on the size of your artwork, materials used, and even the inspiration behind your artwork. (Note: Many judges will be visiting the artwork in person, so be sure to give accurate directions and an address or approximate location).

5. Once you've selected your file and completed the form, click on UPLOAD ART.

6. A message confirming that your artwork has been submitted will appear at the top, along with a link to preview the art you just uploaded.

7. Once submitted, your artwork may take anywhere from a few minutes to a few hours to be received and approved by the Idaho Meth Project. Prior to approval, if you wish to upload a different picture or edit your submission in any way, make your changes quickly and click UPLOAD ART again. Please be aware that you will not be able to make any changes to your submission once it is approved.

PHOTO REQUIREMENTS

- The digital photo you post cannot exceed 2 megabytes (2 MB) and must be a .jpg file.

ADDITIONAL PHOTO TIPS

- If you have one available, use a tripod to support your camera rather than holding it by hand.
- Take several shots from different views, at different times of day, close-up and from farther away, with and without people in the photo so you can select the photo that best represents your artwork.
- Save your work - Upload your photos from the camera to a computer, then burn them to a CD or jump drive so you have a safe, secure backup.
- We want to see your artwork as it is displayed, so please do not alter photos in Photoshop or other photo-editing software.
